Lake County Sheriff's Warrants Team Apprehend Fugitive Hiding in Locked Storage Closet

On August 3, 2017 members of the Lake County Sheriff's Office Warrants Team and the U.S. Marshals Service - Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force (USMS-GLRFTF), apprehended Devyn D. Cedzidlo, 19, of the 9700 block of Bonner Lane, Spring Grove.

Cedzidlo was wanted on a felony warrant (\$150,000.00 bond) for Residential Burglary (arrest warrant obtained regarding a Round Lake Beach Police investigation) and a failure to appear arrest warrant (\$100,000.00 bond) for unlawful possession of a controlled substance (regarding a previous Lindenhurst Police investigation).

In June, members of the Sheriff's Warrants Team began apprehension efforts. At that time, Cedzidlo fled from Illinois to Iowa. On August 2nd, members of the Sheriff's Warrants Team developed information indicating Cedzidlo was likely back home at his Bonner Lane residence. On August 3rd, members of the Sheriff's Warrants Team and USMS-GLRFTF located Cedzidlo inside of his Spring Grove residence.

Upon seeing members of the Warrants Team, Cedzidlo retreated to the basement of the residence and locked himself inside of a storage closet. Warrants Deputies breached the locked door and successfully apprehended Cedzidlo without further incident.

Cedzidlo was transported to the Lake County Jail where he remains held on \$250,000.00 bail. Cedzidlo is due in court on August 11, 2017 at 1:30PM.

Spring Grove Police assisted the Warrants Team during the apprehension effort.

Sheriff Curran reminds the public the defendant is presumed innocent until proven guilty in a court of law. **End of Release**
