I understand that to meet the legal requirements and qualify to apply to the Student Election Judge Program, I must:

- Be a Junior or Senior in good standing and enrolled in a public or private secondary school,
- Be a U.S. citizen at the time of the next election,
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale,
- Have written approval from a parent or guardian and the school principal,
- Satisfactorily complete an election judge training course
- Register to vote if 18 years of age on or before the next General Election.

Additionally, I must:

- Assist other judges and share responsibility for the operation of the voting site,
- Provide a copy of my assignment letter to the appropriate school personnel to receive an excused absence for the day and collect and complete any assignments that are missed.

Time Commitment and Compensation:

- 5:15 AM - 8:15 PM or later. All Election Judges must assist with voting site closing/tear-down procedures.
- Compensation: \$140.00 - Must work on Election Day for the total duration to receive full compensation.
